## The True Guru

(Letter from Svami Sadananda Dasa 18.04.74)

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[...] One thing is certain – : Whenever we think this or that person has made people "bhakta-s", we are from the very start on the wrong track.

The fact is: If a person has aprakrita sukriti<sup>1</sup> then the Paramatma causes the person to meet the *shiksha*-guru who is the instrument to instruct the adept.

The guru *never* poses as the great man who imparts *bhakti* to others, because it is the *hearing* of *Hari-katha*<sup>2</sup> from the lips of the guru, that leads to shraddha<sup>3</sup> in His seva. It is Krishna Who uses the *guru* as *instrument*. [...]
